1) Webb's Goldswift Mission Impossible for Inkleyboys (D)

At two and a half, this well-structured grey dog is just reaching maturity, and is very smartly presented. He has a pleasing head, well-proportioned and furnished, with a dark, kind eye. His strong neck leads into reasonably angled shoulders, and with good bone and width throughout, he makes a most pleasing, balanced picture. His movement was sound with adequate drive from good hindquarters, and he kept his topline on the move.

2) Holder & Howe's Sade Araya Mascotts (B)

A complete contrast to the winner, this rangy fourteen month old dark bitch is very much at the awkward age, very leggy and even with the canine equivalent of teenage spots, a bursa, which sadly detracted a little from what looked like very good movement, She certainly covered the ground extremely well, and when she gets a bit of maturity I think she will be really something to watch out for. She has a pleasing head and lovely reach of neck, nice lay of shoulder, good length of loin and curves in the right places. One for the future.
